#### 3. MEMBERSHIP (Extract)

Membership shall be open, subject to the discretion of the Committee, to all persons interested in the aims of the Society (see note 1 & 2).

- a) Full members.
- b) Student members. Student members must be under 25 years of age and in full-time formal education.
- c) Honorary members. Honorary Membership may be granted to any person, who, in the opinion of the Committee, has rendered outstanding service to the Society, either directly or indirectly. Such membership shall carry the rights of full membership but shall be free from subscriptions. Honorary members must confirm to the secretary on an annual basis that they wish to continue with their membership.
- d) Spouse/Civil partner membership. This is open to the spouses/civil partners of full members, who do not hold a license.
- e) Country membership. This is open to all persons who satisfy the conditions of membership and whose main residence is outside a 50-mile radius of the Society's main meeting place.

#### 4. SUBSCRIPTIONS

a) All subscriptions shall be due and payable within 1 calendar month of the AGM.

The Standard Annual Subscription shall be £12.50.

The Standard Annual Subscription shall be payable by members except for those in the following categories:

- (i) Those under 16 years of age.
- (ii) Those under 25 years of age and in full-time qualifying education.
- (iii) Spouse/Civil partner members.
- (iv) Those who are 65 years of age or over.
- (v) Those in receipt of a means-tested State benefit.
- (vi) Country members.
- (vii) Honorary members.

A Nominal Annual Subscription of £1.00 shall be payable by those in categories (i) and (ii).

A Reduced Annual Subscription of 50% of the Standard Annual Subscription shall be payable by those in categories (iii), (iv) and (v).

A Country Annual Subscription of 40% of the Standard Annual Subscription shall be payable by those in category (vi).

The Committee reserves the right to require proof of entitlement to pay a Nominal, Reduced or Country Subscription.

No subscription is required from members in categories (vii)

b) A new member of the Society shall pay an initial subscription determined by when they join the society, and that subscription shall be in respect of the period from the date of joining to the Year End

c) A member may elect to pay a subscription greater than that required by Rule 4(c) or (d) but if the amount paid exceeds the Standard Annual Subscription then the excess shall be recorded in the Society's accounts as a donation to the Society's funds.

#### Notes

- (1) Membership may include, for example, youngsters, the family and friends of full members whose interest is in the social side rather than amateur radio, or local persons of influence whom it is wished to link with the Society.
- (2) Under 18's must have parental or guardian agreement to membership
